



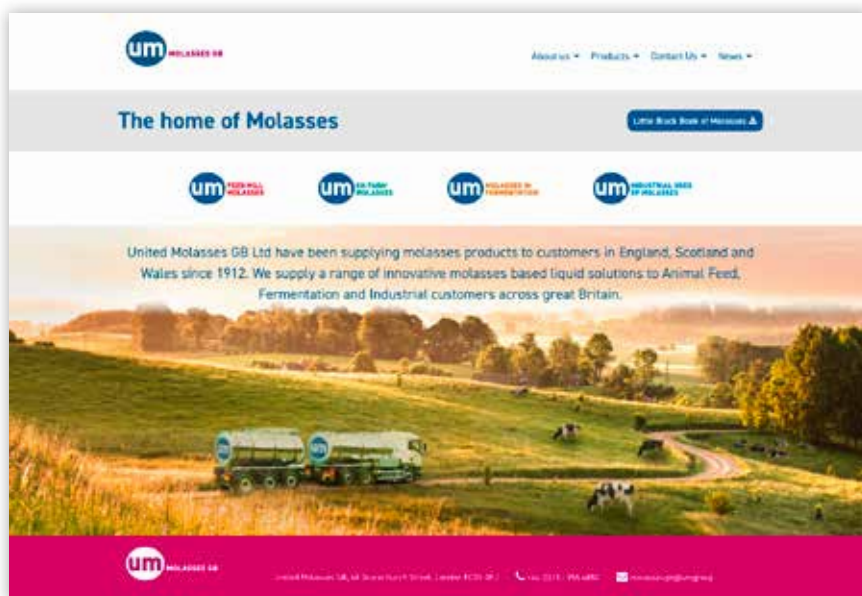

A new product we introduced to our farm line up this year, **Golden Pro 30** is a product that has been developed by UM to offer a **highly palatable alternative** to the distillery syrups such as Pot Ale Syrup or the various biofuel wheat syrup liquids that have been used in ruminant rations in recent years but are now less freely available and not always cost competitive when priced to farm.

Golden Pro 30: Q & A

What is it made from?

Golden Pro 30 is a blend of molasses by-products from the fermentation industry, it also contains UM's signature caramel flavour for enhanced palatability.

Which ruminant diets is it suitable for?

Golden Pro 30 is a very diet versatile product, it can be used very effectively in either grass silage or mixed forage diets especially those which contain large quantities of processed or ground cereals.

Is it a source of "quality" protein?

Yes, Golden Pro 30 is an excellent source of non-urea ERDP so will offer more rumen digestible protein than say the distillery or biofuel syrups that contain only basic crude protein.

How much can I feed?

We would recommend feeding 1 to 2 kg per head/day to mature ruminants, for younger animals we suggest 0.5 to 1.5 kg per head/day.

Is it easy to handle?

Yes, Golden Pro 30 has been specifically formulated to be free flowing at all temperatures so is ideal for use in the winter when the ambient temperatures are typically lower on farm.

Is it available in full arctic loads?

Yes, Golden Pro 30 is available in loads of a minimum quantity of 5 tonnes up to a maximum of 28 tonnes, delivered direct to farm.
